Following the raising of the road kerbs in Cardenden, Fife a solution was needed to stop the rain water that was collecting around the gutter from penetrating into the lower layers of the road, as this would cause rapid degradation.



Not only was a simple, fast and effective repair to the defective asphalt edge provided but minimal traffic management, labour and plant were required for the work. ■

Other road repair products find this area awkward, struggling to achieve adequate compaction. Stirling Lloyd's Crack Infill, a cold liquid applied product, flowed easily into the problematic area.

Though the repair area consisted of both asphalt and concrete substrates, this proved no issue to Safetrack Crack Infill which formed a strong adhesion to both types of surface.
